JOIN THE FEMINIST TRANSNATIONAL CARAVAN!

Are you a passionate advocate for feminism and gender equality? Do you want to be part of a dynamic, European movement that drives change through travelling across Europe, art and street campaigning?

The Feminist Transnational Caravan project is looking for young feminists to join our mission to empower communities and raise awareness across Europe!

THE PROJECT

The Feminist Transnational Caravan is an Erasmus+ Project that empowers young people to stand up for gender justice, diversity and solidarity. Youth organizations from Belgium, Finland, Romania, Serbia and Germany will together create a learning community of 30 young activists and youth workers. We will learn from and with each other and work with creative methodologies and forms of activism. The main part of the project is the transnational caravan in September 2026 in which we will travel from Liège via Cologne/Bonn, Berlin, Wroclaw, Krakow and Timisoara to Bucharest. In each city, we will get into an exchange on intersectional feminism with local activists and organisations, do street activities and organise a movie screening. The caravan ends with the participation in the Feminist Film Festival in Bucharest.

PARTICANTS' ROLE

We are inviting you to apply to become a participant in this exciting project. **There are two ways ("tracks") you can get involved:**

- 1. **Local Activist Track**: Participate in the project activities happening in Germany, including: a four day exchange on intersectional feminism, supporting the stops in Köln/Bonn and Berlin, participation in the development of the online campaign and local events after the caravan. It is also possible to join only for parts of this track.
- 2. **Caravan Track**: Be part of the whole Caravan! Take on a deeper role by joining the full Transnational Caravan. This requires travelling with the group to all specified dates and locations across the partner countries (see below) as well as participating in the local activities in Germany. No exceptions possible here.

PROJECT COMMITMENT AND DATES

Your full participation and commitment are essential for the success of this project. Therefore, we expect you to commit to the following international and local dates. Please have in mind that this is a project, not a vacation. <u>Selected participants for the caravan track will need to commit to the following international dates:</u>

- exchange seminar on intersectional feminism March 23 to 26, 2026, in Ostbevern close to Münster
- international training June 27 to July 3, 2026, in Serbia
- several preparation meetings July to August, 2026, online
- transnational caravan August 29 to September 20, 2026, travelling from Liège to Bucharest
- **final dissemination event(s)** end of 2026 in Germany (date and place will be chosen together with the volunteers from Germany)

If you just want to participate in the exchange seminar on intersectional feminism and/or the dissemination event(s), check out the local activist track.

WHO WE'RE LOOKING FOR

To ensure a strong and committed team, all applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Age: be between 18 and 35 years old.
- Language: be fluent in English, the working language of the project.
- Commitment: be ready to sign a volunteering contract which includes:
 - committing to all scheduled project dates (incl. the final dissemination activity).
 - adherence to the project's Code of Conduct.
 - consent to appear in photos and videos produced for awareness-raising and project documentation.
- For the caravan track, you must be able to travel to all project countries (EU + Serbia) and comfortable with intensive travel, which may include occasional instances of night (sleeping) trains between destinations.

We are committed to building a diverse and inclusive group, paying close attention to diversity in its broader sense in the selection process. All genders welcome.

LOGISTICS AND CONDITIONS

All costs related to the project activities (travel, accomodation and food) are fully covered by the project. Food will be mostly vegetarian/vegan. Accomodation will always be in shared rooms. We will adhere to sustainability guidelines and a strict Code of Conduct to ensure a safe, inclusive and respectful environment for all.
