

# LET'S TALK CLIMATE

## PROJECT INFOPACK

The youth exchange 'Let's talk climate!' is organised by Eine Welt Netz NRW e.V. in cooperation with the Nord Süd Forum München and the LCOY conference.

By bringing together young people from different countries currently living in Germany, we will create a global picture of climate change and activism.

At the same time we will enjoy spending time as an international group, discover youth engagement in Germany and worldwide and hopefully build new friendships.

The highlight of the week will be visiting the LCOY Germany: Europe's largest youth climate conference that takes place in Munich from 16th to 18th October. Our group will contribute a workshop and participate in the full program together.

### CAN I PARTICIPATE?

**To participate in the program, you must:**

- currently be staying in Germany, preferably as part of an exchange or educational program (e.g. weltwärts, kulturweit, ASA, Ausbildung, a semester abroad, etc.)
- speak and understand English at a communication level and German at a basic level
- be aged between 18 and 30
- be interested in learning about climate action

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## WHAT WILL WE DO?

Climate change is a tough issue. We will tackle it with a fun and interactive week, bringing together our diverse strengths, perspectives and ideas while meeting new friends from Germany and around the globe!

The week will start with 3 interactive workshop days to prepare us for an enriching visit to the LCOY youth and climate conference (2,5 days).

Workshops include (among others):

- ☑ Help, I am lost! – Short introduction to climate change
- ☑ How am I concerned? – Sharing our personal experiences
- ☑ International night - Getting to know each other's cultures

During the conference, we will have the opportunity not only to exchange with other youth and a broad range of representatives from German society. We will also contribute to shaping the conference through our diverse backgrounds and global perspectives. We will therefore prepare and hold a workshop together as part of the LCOY conference program. You will receive more details shortly before the program.

## Costs of Participation

Costs for accommodation, food and participation in all program points are covered. Travel costs will be covered up to a maximum of 90€ per person. If your travel costs would exceed this amount and you cannot cover it yourself, let us know in advance.

Wait for our confirmation of participation before booking.

To get the travel costs reimbursed, you must keep all tickets! Make sure to save the pdf versions of the tickets (not just screenshots from the app).

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## WHERE AND WHEN

The whole project will take place in Munich. **We meet on October 12, 3pm, in Munich (district "Berg am Laim").**

From October 12 to 16, we will stay in a big apartment in the east of the city. You will be accommodated in rooms of 2-5 people. We will cook together.

From October 16 to 18, we will take part in the LCOY conference and move to their accommodation in a gym/classroom. To do so, you need to bring an air mattress and sleeping bag. This is a common accommodation in German youth engagement and usually quite fun. If you do not have an air mattress or sleeping bag, first ask friends/colleagues. Most German people have them and you should be able to borrow. If that's not possible, reach out to us.

Food is also provided at the LCOY conference. Check out their website for further information.

## HOW DO I GET THERE?

We will meet at the apartment/workshop space in Munich (district "Berg am Laim") , October 12, 3pm. The exact address will be shared with you before.

Please make sure to plan your travels in a way that you will be there in time. The program will start at 4pm. If you travel by Deutsche Bahn, make sure to plan some extra time for delays. 😊

Travel costs will be covered up to 90€ per person. You can book a train in 2nd class or use a bus (e.g. flixbus). We will not cover flights or use of private cars. If you are unsure about your journey's reimbursement, please reach out to us before booking.



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## CAN I STAY LONGER IN MUNICH?

Yes, you can stay up to four days longer. However, the costs for these "extra-days" (such as accommodation and food) will not be covered by us. Also, volunteers, trainees and interns are reminded to check with their employee for leave.

## WHAT DO I HAVE TO BRING?

Here's an incomplete list of things you should bring:

- **air mattress & sleeping bag**
- Comfortable, warm clothes
- rain jacket
- house shoes/ slippers
- something (picture, movie, news article, song, tool..) that reflects your relation to climate change
- Games, books, toys, music, musical instruments...
- something to write (a note book, pens)
- refillable water bottle
- toiletries and a towel, medicine if needed
- passport
- (health) insurance certificate ("Krankenkassenkarte")
